FLEXIBLE PAYMENT PLANS

Monthly Automated Plan:

1. \$50 Deposit plus \$120 Travel Insurance (required) due at sign-up
2. Billed automatically to your credit card or checking account
3. Balance divided into equal monthly payments

Full Payment Plan:

Pay in full at time of enrollment

4-Step Manual Plan (not automatic):

1. \$99 Deposit plus \$120 Travel Insurance (required) due at sign-up
2. 30 days after registration, 2nd payment of \$500 is due
3. 75% of your balance due 110 days prior to departure
4. Remainder of balance due 65 days prior to departure
