


We're back © How has Covid changed our trips?



- Flexibility and adaptability are KEY for all international travel
 - Vaccinations are being required prior to travel
 - Negative Covid tests pre- and post-tour are required
 - Masks, spacing, and traveling/rooming in pods are required
 - Passports are taking longer to get
 - > Note: ALL OF THESE MAY CHANGE BEFORE WE TRAVEL ... so be FLEXIBLE



- Explorica, State Department, CDC
 - Matthew and Jason don't decide when it is safe to travel ... we have a network of experts.
- We will re-evaluate every trip IF something arises in that area, region, etc.
- Seen it before...Japan and Tsunami, China and North Korea issues, France and train strikes, Turkey and security issues, Covid 19 pandemic.





Monthly Payment Plan Benefits

What is included?

- Round trip airfare from Spokane
- Lodging in Hotels
 - Students: 3 to 4 per room depending on location (students with students)
 - > Adults: 2 per room (adults with adults)
- Transportation throughout the trip from MMS back to MMS
- Explorica tour director to guide us on the ground
- Breakfast and dinner daily
- Guided sightseeing/walking tours
- Entrance fees to selected attractions







What is **not** included?

- > \$50 for two pre-trip team building activities
- Lunches, beverages, and snacks throughout the day
- Passport fees
- Covid tests as needed
- > Souvenirs
- Additional airline baggage fees
- Phone calls and Wi-Fi Access
- We recommend \$500 for additional expenses on tour



Spending Cash

- \$500 spending cash encouraged for lunches and souvenirs
- ➤ If Covid tests are required by countries or airlines, then this is an additional expense to the applicant estimated \$200

Four Steps

- 1. Complete an application and return it to one of the trip leaders ASAP order matters (see application due date on top of the application Wednesday, November 17th at 3:30 pm).
- 2. Wait for a confirmation email from the trip leaders by Friday, November 19th.
- 3. Once your application is accepted, complete the online instructions to enroll and pay your non-refundable \$182 (\$50 sign up plus \$132 required Insurance fee). This **must** be completed by 3:30 pm Friday, Dec 3rd.
- 4. Attend all group meetings

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Can adults/parents go?
 - Yes, applications are available tonight. One parent per student.
- Can a younger or older sibling go?
 - \triangleright This trip is for current 5th to 8th grade students only.
- Can a relative go on the trip?
 - Yes, but they must complete an adult application and meet the age requirements of 21.
- What if I cannot pay the full trip cost?
 - Once you commit to this trip you are obligated to pay your way.
 - There are penalties for early withdrawal with Explorica.
- How do I know if I am a good applicant?
 - We are looking for responsible, flexible, curious, and group-centered people. This trip is about the GROUP not any one individual.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Dietary options?
 - Explorica does have different meal options depending on individual needs.
- Medications while abroad?
 - > Students are responsible for all needed medications (please notify trip leaders of ANY medical issues prior to the trip).





Participant Selection Timeline

- November 8 Parent meeting and applications are out
- November 17 Applications are DUE by 3:30 PM and will be reviewed by the trip leaders
- November 19 Acceptance letters are sent out electronically
- ➤ **December 3** Accepted travelers must be enrolled online with Explorica by 3:30 pm and have paid the non-refundable \$50 fee plus required insurance \$132 (\$182 total).
- December 3 after 3:30 pm Accepted applicants who are not enrolled will lose their spot to an alternate who will be informed by 6:00 pm.
- December 10 by 3:00 pm Alternate travelers must be signed up with Explorica
- December 13 1st all group meeting 7:00 pm via Zoom
