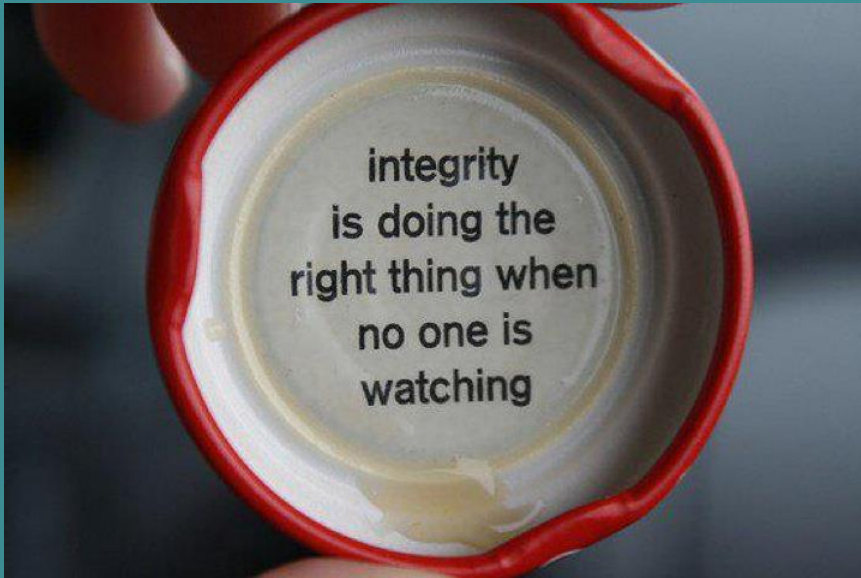

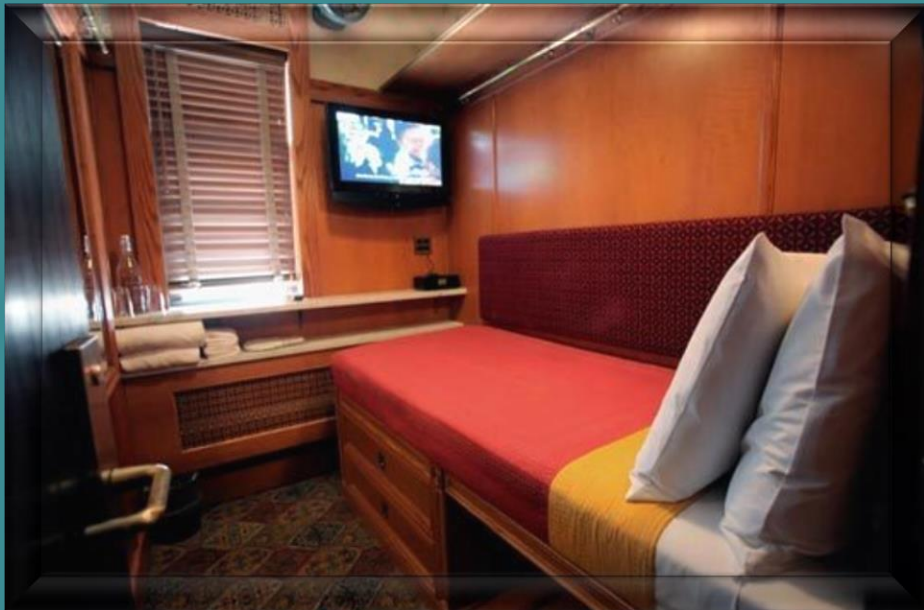

Container size is a security measure

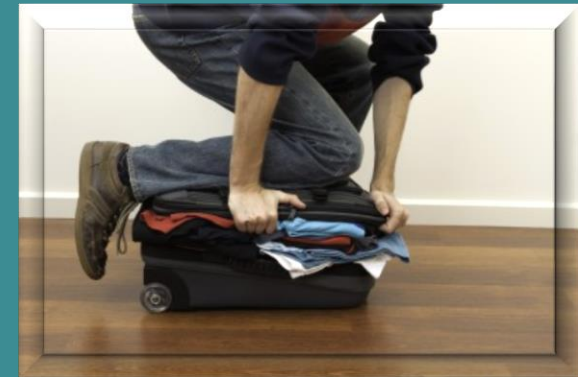
1 quart-size, clear plastic, zip-top bag holding 3 ounce or smaller containers
