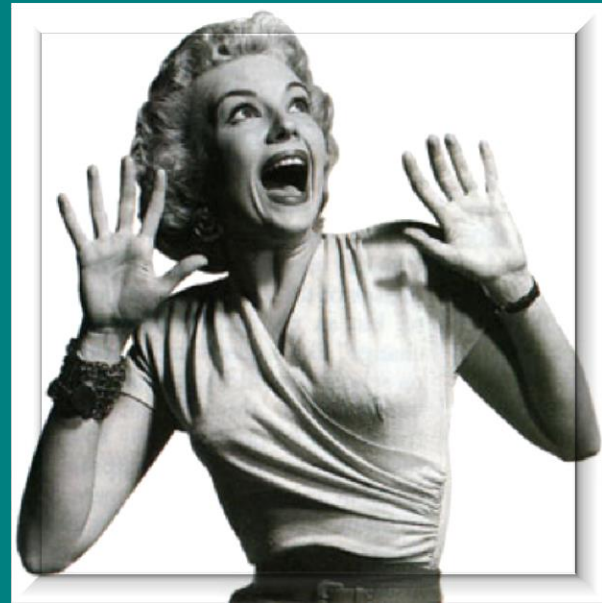
Spain and France Trip 2014 Schedule of Meetings
