EF Group Rules and Roles

The Prado Museum

Madrid, Spain



- One of the greatest museums in the world
 - 7,600 paintings, 1,000 sculptures, 4,800 prints and 8,200 drawings
 - El Greco, Velázquez, Goya, Raphael, and Rembrandt



Palacio Real “Royal Palace” Madrid, Spain

- Home of King Don Juan Carlos I
- Built in 1734
- Still home of the royal family



Salamanca, Spain

- Home of the historic Universidad de Salamanca

- One of the only places in the world to have two connected Cathedrals



- Famous for the Plaza Mayor



Toledo, Spain

- The former capital and the cultural heart of Spain.



La Sagrada Familia “The Holy Family”

Barcelona, Spain

- Construction: 1882 begins
- Completion date: 2041???
- Architect- Gaudí
- Gaudí is buried in the crypt
- One of the largest cathedrals in Spain



Cite-de-Carcassonne



- Parts of its fortifications date to 1st century AD
- A beautiful fortress strategically placed that was never successfully besieged

“All Aboard!”

- Night trains are an incredibly popular way to travel in Europe
- Fall asleep in Carcassonne and wake up in Paris
 - A 480 mile journey all while we SLEEP 😊



Mona Lisa

- Painted by Renaissance master Leonardo de Vinci c. 1503 and completed c. 1517
- Arguably the world's best known painting
- Deceptively small at only 30 x 21 inches
- Housed in the Louvre (Paris) since 1797



Arc de Triomphe



- Commissioned in 1806 by Napoleon
- A triumphal arch modeled after the *Arch of Titus* in Rome
- Took 30 years to complete!!



Palace of Versailles



- Originally a hunting lodge, the transformation to imperial palace was initiated by Louis the 14th (the Sun King) c. 1668
